## A Day at the Metropolitan Museum of Art with Andrew Lattimore on Sunday, November 13th

Enjoy a four-hour guided tour of collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in NYC with a master artist and historian. Andrew will guide you through period rooms of the American Wing to see work by notable artists such as Whistler, Chase, Innes and Eakins. You'll also visit the 'viewable storage' area where you'll be able to intimately view many, often unseen, masterpieces. Then, off to the European Wing, where you discover the works of the 19th century Impressionists. Reflect on color, light, and brush strokes in paintings by Monet, Renoir, Degas, as well as American artists who were trained in Europe such as Cassat, Whistler, and Sargent.



Cost of trip doesn't include transportation. BAC will help make transportation arrangements, but you will be responsible for getting there. People who would like to take Metro North should plan on taking the 9:30 train (arrives at Grand Central at 11am). Andrew will be traveling on that train from the Beacon station. You then have the option of meeting Andrew at the main information booth at Grand Central (11:10) to take a subway to the Met together. Alternately, you can meet Andrew at the Great Hall at the Met, which is located at 1000 Fifth Ave (and 83rd Street) at 11:45. BAC will keep a list of people who want to car pool. There is a parking lot at the Met. There are also discount parking lot options at [www.nyc.centralparking.com](http://www.nyc.centralparking.com). The group will start with an early lunch at the cafeteria (it's much easier to find seating before noon). The tour will begin at 12:30pm in the American Wing. Please wear comfortable shoes (there will be a considerable amount of walking) and if you prefer you can bring your own refreshments.
